Explicación

Los verbos 'love', 'like' y 'hate' se usan para expresar gustos y preferencias.

Pueden ir seguidos de un sustantivo o de un verbo con la forma -ing (gerundio).

Ejemplos:

- I love pizza. / I love cooking.
- She likes animals. / She likes playing tennis.
- They hate traffic. / They hate waiting.

Afirmativa:

- I like reading. / He loves football.

Negativa:

- I don't like reading. / He doesn't love football.

Interrogativa:

- Do you like reading? / Does she love pizza?

Recuerda:

- Añade 's' en tercera persona singular (He/She/It): She loves, He likes, etc.
- En negativa e interrogativa usamos don't / doesn't.
