- Sujeto + verbo 'to be' + going to + verbo en forma base
- Ejemplos:

I am going to study. (Voy a estudiar)

She is going to travel. (Ella va a viajar)

Are you going to cook? (¿Vas a cocinar?)

#### **Formas:**

- Afirmativa: I am going to play.

- Negativa: He is not going to eat.

- Interrogativa: Are they going to come?

#### **Contracciones:**

- I'm / You're / He's / She's / We're / They're
