Explicación (nivel A1)

El verbo 'have got' significa 'tener' en español. Se usa para hablar de posesiones, relaciones y características.

Por ejemplo: I have got a car. (Tengo un coche)

En presente simple:

- I have got / You have got / We have got / They have got
- He has got / She has got / It has got

Ejemplos afirmativos:

- I have got a dog. (Tengo un perro)
- She has got long hair. (Ella tiene el pelo largo)
- They have got a big house. (Tienen una casa grande)

Formas negativas:

- I haven't got / He hasn't got...

Forma larga: I have not got / He has not got

Forma corta: I haven't got / He hasn't got

📌 Ejemplos negativos:

- I haven't got any brothers. (No tengo hermanos)
- He hasn't got a car. (Él no tiene coche)

Forma interrogativa:

- Have I got...? / Have you got...? / Has he got...?

☐ Ejemplos interrogativos:

- Have you got a pen? (¿Tienes un bolígrafo?)

- Has she got any pets? (¿Tiene mascotas?)

Notas:

- “Has got” se usa solo con he, she, it.

- “Have got” se usa con I, you, we, they.

- En inglés americano se usa más 'have' sin 'got'. En esta ficha usamos la forma británica 'have got'.
