Explicación (nivel A1)

El verbo modal 'can' se utiliza en inglés para hablar de habilidades, posibilidad y permiso.

Usos principales:

- Habilidad: I can swim. (Sé nadar)
- Posibilidad: It can be dangerous. (Puede ser peligroso)
- Permiso: Can I go to the bathroom? (¿Puedo ir al baño?)

Estructura:

- Afirmativa: sujeto + can + verbo base → She can speak English.
- Negativa: sujeto + cannot / can't + verbo base → He can't drive.
- Interrogativa: Can + sujeto + verbo base? → Can you help me?

Nota:

- 'Can' no cambia con la persona. No se añade 's' en tercera persona.
- El verbo que va después de 'can' siempre está en su forma base (sin 'to').
