



### Common Mistakes with Prepositions – Ficha práctica

Muchos estudiantes de inglés cometen errores frecuentes con las preposiciones, ya que su uso no siempre coincide con el español. Aquí tienes una lista de errores comunes y su corrección:

- ❓ **\*\*Married with\*\*** → ❓ **\*\*Married to\*\*** – She is married **\*\*to\*\*** a doctor.
- ❓ **\*\*Depend of\*\*** → ❓ **\*\*Depend on\*\*** – It depends **\*\*on\*\*** the weather.
- ❓ **\*\*Listen music\*\*** → ❓ **\*\*Listen to music\*\*** – I like listening **\*\*to\*\*** music.
- ❓ **\*\*Enter to the room\*\*** → ❓ **\*\*Enter the room\*\*** – He entered **\*\*the room\*\***.
- ❓ **\*\*Discuss about\*\*** → ❓ **\*\*Discuss\*\*** – We discussed **\*\*the problem\*\*** (no preposición).
- ❓ **\*\*Arrive to\*\*** (cuando se habla de un lugar específico) → ❓ **\*\*Arrive at/in\*\*** – She arrived **\*\*at\*\*** the station.
- ❓ **\*\*Wait me\*\*** → ❓ **\*\*Wait for me\*\*** – Please wait **\*\*for\*\*** me.
- ❓ **\*\*Angry to\*\*** → ❓ **\*\*Angry with\*\*** – I'm angry **\*\*with\*\*** him.
- ❓ **\*\*Think in\*\*** → ❓ **\*\*Think about\*\*** – I'm thinking **\*\*about\*\*** my future.
- ❓ **\*\*Good in\*\*** – ❓ **\*\*Good at\*\*** – He is good **\*\*at\*\*** English.
