

Common Mistakes with Prepositions – Ficha práctica

Muchos estudiantes de inglés cometen errores frecuentes con las preposiciones, ya que su uso no siempre coincide con el español. Aquí tienes una lista de errores comunes y su corrección:

2^{**}Married with** \rightarrow 2^{**} **Married to** - She is married **to** a doctor.
```

- $2 **Depend of ** \rightarrow 2 **Depend on ** It depends **on ** the weather.$
- 2 **Listen music** $\rightarrow 2$ **Listen to music** I like listening **to** music.
- 2^{**} Enter to the room** $\rightarrow 2^{**}$ Enter the room** He entered **the room**.
- 2^{**} Discuss about** $\rightarrow 2^{**}$ Discuss** We discussed **the problem** (no preposición).
- 2^{**} Arrive to** (cuando se habla de un lugar específico) $\rightarrow 2^{**}$ Arrive at/in** She arrived **at** the station.
- 2^{**} Wait me** $\rightarrow 2^{**}$ **Wait for me** Please wait **for** me.
- 2 **Angry to** $\rightarrow 2$ **Angry with** I'm angry **with** him.
- 2^{**} Think in** $\rightarrow 2^{**}$ Think about** I'm thinking **about** my future.
- 2 **Good in** 2 **Good at** He is good **at** English.
