because	I'm late because I missed the bus.
so	It was raining, so we stayed home.
or	Do you want tea or coffee?
then	We ate dinner, then we watched a movie.
after	After lunch, I took a nap.
before	I wash my hands before eating.
also	He is a teacher. He is also a writer.
although	Although it was cold, we went outside.
