



### Frases Negativas en Inglés A1

Las frases negativas en inglés se forman colocando el auxiliar 'do not' o 'does not' (en tercera persona) antes del verbo principal. Esta estructura es esencial para expresar que algo no ocurre, no es cierto o no se hace.

Estructura general:

- Sujeto + do/does + not + verbo base

Ejemplos:

- I do not like coffee.
- She does not work on Sundays.
- They do not speak French.

Contraídas:

- I don't like coffee.
- She doesn't work on Sundays.
