

Prepositions of Movement – Ficha práctica

Las preposiciones de movimiento en inglés indican dirección o desplazamiento de un lugar a otro. Se utilizan con verbos de movimiento como 'go', 'walk', 'run', 'drive', entre otros.

Las más comunes son:

To: hacia un destino – She is going **to** the office.

Into: hacia dentro de algo – He walked **into** the room.

Onto: hacia encima de una superficie – The cat jumped **onto** the table.

Out of: hacia fuera de algo – He ran **out of** the building.

Off: desde una superficie hacia abajo – She fell **off** the bike.

Over: por encima de algo – They jumped **over** the fence.

Through: a través de – We walked **through** the park.

Across: de un lado al otro – He ran **across** the street.

Along: siguiendo una línea o borde – They walked **along** the river.

Past: pasando por delante de – We drove **past** the school.
