

Pronombres personales en inglés – Nivel A1

Los pronombres personales en inglés A1 son palabras que se utilizan para sustituir a los nombres de las personas o cosas. Se dividen en sujeto y objeto, pero en esta ficha trabajaremos los pronombres sujeto: I, you, he, she, it, we, you, they.

Por ejemplo:

- I am a student. (Yo soy estudiante.)
- She is my friend. (Ella es mi amiga.)
