



### **Pronombres de Objeto en Inglés A1**

Los pronombres de objeto en inglés se usan para reemplazar al objeto de una oración, es decir, a quien recibe la acción del verbo. Son los siguientes:

- me (me)
- you (te)
- him (lo, le a él)
- her (la, le a ella)
- it (lo/la para cosas o animales)
- us (nos)
- them (los, las)

Ejemplo:

- I see her every day. (La veo todos los días)
- They call us in the afternoon. (Nos llaman por la tarde)
